1. Eligibility :

Maximum 2 Rated Players above elo 1600 and 3 below elo 1600 of any age and maximum 2 player from outside Tripura for each team are eligible. Register your name:

2. SCOPE:

Top 10 teams of “TRIPURA SUPER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 1.0 ” will play “TRIPURA PREMIER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 1.0 ”. If any of the team doesn't want to participate in “TRIPURA PREMIER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 1.0” then next team will be consider to to play premier league 1.0

Top 8 Teams of “TRIPURA PREMIER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 1.0” will remain in “TRIPURA PREMIER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 2.0” but least scored 2 teams of “TRIPURA PREMIER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 1.0” will be relegated to “TRIPURA SUPER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 2.0”

Top 2 teams of “TRIPURA SUPER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 2.0” will join “TRIPURA PREMIER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 2.0” along with top 6 teams of “TRIPURA PREMIER DIVISION CHESS LEAGUE 1.0”.

The relegation and up gradation will go on according to this process.

3. COMPOSITION OF SUPER DIVISION TEAM: (No Team Limit)

5 players in a team (1 reserve player)

Maximum 2 Rated Players above elo 1600 and 3 below elo 1600 of any age and maximum 2 player from outside Tripura for each team are eligible..

4. Prizes:

Team Prizes: 1st Prize ₹ 20000 + Trophy
2nd Prize ₹ 15000 + Trophy
3rd Prize ₹ 10000 + Trophy

Board Prizes: 1 trophy each (1st, 2nd, 3rd) for top 5 board prize winner.

Online Merit Certificate will be issued to all the participants.

5. Dress Code:

The players of individual club team must wear the common uniform. This will be strictly enforced.

6. Entries/Entry Fee:

All entries to be forwarded by all club teams directly to All Tripura Chess Association along with FIDE or Active AICF Id of players with prescribed entry fee.

7. Entry Fee Structure:

Entry Fee: ₹ 2000 per team (Rupees Two thousand hundred only)

8. Last date of entry fee: Please note that the entry fee structure is valid till 25th January 2026.

No entry will be entertained after that. However, All Tripura Chess Association will have the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.

9. System of Play:

The Championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Team Swiss system. A total of 9 (nine) rounds shall be played.

10. Starting Rank of the team:

The seeding of the teams will be done on the basis of the average rating of the best 5 players. While sending entries, the names of all the players with their FIDE ID and their respective FIDE ratings, if any, should be given to enable the arbiters to arrive at the teams' average rating for seeding purposes. These names and ratings should be reconfirmed in person at the Technical Meeting. The Fixed Board Order should be decided by the respective team Captain/Manager before/at the technical meeting.

11. Default Time: Default time for arriving to the chessboard is 10 minutes.

12. Time Control: The rate of play shall be 25 minutes with an increment of 10 second per move from move number one (rapid format)

13. Tie Break:

According to the latest tie break regulations effective from 1st August 2024, Berlin system is no more used and it has been removed from the tie breaks. The four tie breaks mentioned in the regulations for team events are:

- 1) Match Points (default as the primary score)
 - 2) Direct Encounter using Match Points
 - 3) Game Points (applying Unplayed Round Management)
 - 4) Sonneborn Berger EMGSB (applying Unplayed Round Management)
 - 5) Scores and Scheduled Strength Combination (SSSC)
- N.B: Tie Breaks may change according to latest guideline by FIDE / AICF

14. Protest:

Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 3000/- (Rupees two thousand only) within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is up held.

15. Appeals Committee:

Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member appeals committee shall be formed by the ATCA

16. Interpretation:

For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. However, such changes/ or inclusion will be subject to ATCA clearance. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

17. RESPONSIBILITY OF TEAM OWNERS:

Travel, Accommodation, Food, expenses of players and coaches are covered by team owners. Owners are responsible for team Jersey and Branding within the guideline.

18. Withdrawal:

Any withdrawal from the tournament must be notified to the Chief Arbiter with acceptable reasons. The entry fee once paid shall not be refunded if the withdrawal from the championship is done after the publication of first-round pairings.

19. Disqualification:

No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.

20. Registration of Player with AICF:

All participants in the event shall be registered with AICF for the year 2025-2026 before forwarding the entries for the event. Online AICF Registration can be done at the website www.prs.aicf.in/players

21. Electronic Devices:

All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall. **Those who are having mobile phones or wearing watches during their play will be declared lost.**
